Bylaws

1. Annual Membership dues are \$150, and are due as follows: \$50 is due by Cinco de Mayo of every year for all members and \$100 on the 16th of September every year for all general members. A two for one discount for the 16th of September payment will be allowed when there are two general members in a household. The combination locks to the Clubhouse and the passwords to the internet will be changed on the due dates. After 30 days, any member who has not paid their dues will be taken off the roll. If those members wish to reenlist they may do so but will lose their seniority and will have to pay the application fee of \$25 to be reinstated.
2. Membership is open to men and women of any race, at least 21 years of age, with any style or make of motorcycle. In order to join the club, a candidate must be recommended by a current member in good standing, referred to a sponsor for membership, and is required to sign an acceptance of the bylaws. Only sponsoring members may accept a candidate for membership. A one-time \$25 Application Fee will be charged to all new members. All new members must attend one meeting to be introduced by their referring member in order to complete the membership process.
3. All Clubhouse rules fall under the Bylaws. (See Clubhouse Rules)
4. Discipline/Removal of any member can take effect for any reason by the majority vote of the Original 2005 Founding and Current Officers due to any inappropriate behavior of a member. Once membership has been revoked all emblems, keys and the membership cards must be surrendered to the PVRMC with no refunds.
5. Bylaws may be added, modified, or deleted by a simple majority of the Original 2005 Founding Officers and those appointed as such.
6. Any officer vacancy may be filled by a simple majority of the Current Officers and notification to all members shall be made as soon as practical.
7. Any member who wishes to be added to the agenda of an officer's meeting to be heard regarding any issues they may have; may do so providing that the member notifies the Secretary, seven days in advance of the meeting. The member will be allowed to talk, uninterrupted during an open session. After the member finishes, the officers will be given the opportunity to ask questions, but will not respond to the member's request until a closed session discussion is completed. The member will be notified as soon as practical with a response.
8. Wearing a Patch (colors) is optional, which also requires it (patches) to be surrendered upon resignation or revocation in good condition with no refunds. No emblems or patches can be displayed above the PVRMC Patch/Emblem. Below or to the side is allowed.
9. Members are expressly prohibited from using or misusing our logo and it may not be duplicated without express written consent of the PVRMC. We own all rights to PVRMC Patch/Emblem which is a registered trademark and all questions regarding its use should be directed to the Merchandising Director who will in turn bring it to the board.



Clubhouse Rules

1. Be responsible for your clubhouse! “Every member has a key”. This is about trust in your fellow “Villista”. Always remain respectful, kind, courteous, and friendly to all in our clubhouse.
2. All members will have a key and alarm code to the clubhouse. All members and guests must sign in and out on the Clubhouse Journal located at the entrance of the Cantina from the Bay. Last member locks up. Members may invite guests who are 21 years of age or older provided that the member is at the clubhouse to escort their guest from the gate. Members may bring their children to the Clubhouse provided they are under the direct supervision of the adult member. After 10:00 p.m. children are only allowed in East Wing.
3. All beverages donated to club will be made available by clubhouse for a donation. Money donated will be used to purchase and re-stock. All profits will go to clubhouse. All recycled cans & bottles will benefit the clubhouse.
4. The Clubhouse is available for special events use providing that the member notify the President in advance of the event. The parameters will be made by a case by case basis with a majority vote of the Original Founding and Current Officers.
5. One bedroom on the East/West side will be designated as sleeping quarters for a guest spending the night at the discretion of an officer of the club. This is a courtesy for out of town guests and also as a safety precaution for riders who may be too impaired to ride or drive.
6. The clubhouse is available 24-7. All noise must subside between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
7. Parking inside the fence and around the clubhouse is for Motorcycles only. Cars will be allowed to park in the designated car parking area west of the clubhouse fence.
8. The West-side of building will be used for cantina, food, social hall, and a bedroom. The East side of building restroom will be reserved for women only and the back bedroom will also be a “ladies lounge area “. Men’s only restroom is located near back door in the center room “Bay”. East side of building will also be used for Officer’s Meetings, club merchandise storage, equipment & tool storage, etc.
